IT WAS already tough to meet all of our household bills. We never really knew how expensive treatment for cancer could be. With mounting medical bills, time off work, and having to rearrange schedules for treatments, our thin budget was struggling to make ends meet.

IT IS reality that a high percent of people are affected by this diagnosis.

It is rare to meet someone who does not know a single person who has battled breast cancer. This diagnosis is indiscriminate to gender, income, or background.

IT IS difficult to imagine how devastating this diagnosis is while juggling finances, work, kids, and life responsibilities. Many families in Northern Colorado face the fear of this disease and its treatment all while adding to their financial burden.

IT IS treatable, but it is an expensive treatment. Treatment can cost up to \$185,000 in 24 months. This cost is simply an expense that is not easily absorbed by a family. In many cases, insurance and other benefits can reduce costs, but the remaining cost is a financial burden. Families need the most help financially for non-covered or partially covered treatments.

[Funding from] Tough Enough to Wear Pink enabled us to coordinate services with our Loveland Community Health Center. They identified and referred women to McKee for breast screenings and diagnostics, and we provided these to woman, using the Tough Enough grant funds.

The lymphedema sleeves were for women who were already diagnosed with and treated for breast cancer and because of the treatment, had developed painful swelling in their arms. The sleeves helped reduce the arm swelling. Having the Tough Enough to Wear Pink funds available for these sleeves helped the women live with less pain and be more active.





REDUCTION IN BREAST CANCER MORTALITY **1990 WITH MAMMOGRAPHY** NTHEU











Four Generations Fighting For A Gure

Four generations of the Rankin family have supported "Tough Enough to Wear Pink" fundraising efforts to benefit local breast cancer patients for the past decade. The family passion for the cause increased when Barbara Rankin, mother of three of the initial founders, was treated for pre-cancerous cells in her breast. The original founders include family members Sharon (Rankin) Shirack, Doug Shirack, Alan Rankin, Bonnie Rankin and Vicki (Rankin) Lynch along with close family friend Daren Shawver.

"We've always been very close," Barbara says of her family. "Taking on a family initiative to benefit breast cancer was natural for us."

Alan Rankin introduced the affiliation when he served on the Fair and Rodeo Board. "We were looking for a charitable organization to support through the rodeo. Tough Enough to Wear Pink was identified with the rodeo and the issue of breast cancer nationwide." he says. "When I asked the family about acquiring the rights to the name and doing fundraising, the cause hit home for us." In order to use the trademark name, the family must meet specific criteria and provide descriptions of their events on an annual basis.

The family's passion for the cause is based on personal experience. Barbara's husband died of prostate cancer and her father-in-law survived a bout with the disease. Two close family friends who lost their battle with breast cancer also inspired their efforts.

"Through the years, friends of family members have volunteered for our fundraisers, "Sharon says. "Their participation and community participation is increasing every year."
