Tales From Michigan Stadium

Jim Brandstatter, inducted into the Michigan Sports Hall of Fame 2014 and the Gridiron Great Hall of Fame 2014, is a member of the Broadcaster Hall of Fame and Lansing Sports Hall of Fame. His broadcasting career has spanned 50 years – entirely in Michigan and he was named "Sportscaster of the Year in Michigan" by the National Sportscasters/Sportswriters Association in 2004 and 2008.

Jim broadcast more than 1,000 football games for Michigan teams, 43 years on the air as the color analyst or play by play voice for Michigan Football and 31 years for the Detroit Lions NFL. One of the few serving both college and professional broadcasts across the country, and he did it for three decades. Jim



retired from regular broadcasting following the 2021 football season.

Nicknamed "Brandy" by his broadcast partners, Jim hosted and produced a weekly University of Michigan Live Radio Show for decades, starting with Coach Bo Schembechler called "Brandy & Bo", which won MAB Best in Category Award. Jim is also a published author. "Tales from Michigan Stadium" became a top selling sports book, followed by "Tales from Michigan Stadium II." And, an audio book, "Voices from Michigan Stadium" is in the works.

Jim's sense of humor and his ability to inspire and motivate people to set and achieve goals keeps him busy energizing community and corporate leaders as well as students.

How GTO Proceeds are Used in the Community and Around the World
















- "Helping Kids Succeed." RCAA's youth programs target those whose future development is impaired by physical, cultural, emotional, financial, and social obstacles. In 2020-21 the Community Allocations Committee processed 30 applications and funded12 local nonprofit projects for a total of \$57,000 given to our local community.
- Students Taking a Renewed Interest in the Value of Education (STRIVE). A scholarship program
 of Rotary volunteers who mentor high school seniors at Ann Arbor's Pathways to Success Academic
 Campus. Rotary members serve as mentors for the high school students, encouraging them to
 improve their academic achievements with the possibility of an education beyond high school,
 currently specifically focused on attending Washtenaw Community College. In June 2021 scholarships
 to Washtenaw Community College were offered to 11 graduating seniors.
- International Humanitarian Projects. Major initiatives in 2020-21 included the approval of a Global Grant in Ghana for the construction of a borehole in a remote part of the country, support for the Haiti Nursing Foundation to purchase equipment for remote teaching, and, in partnership with the Ann Arbor North Rotary Club, a project in India to support the creation of additional oxygenated beds owing to the high number of COVID cases. A total of \$25,575 in grants was distributed to eight projects.

Proceeds of the GTO event provides a significant percentage of the Club's Community Service revenue, in addition to support from our members and distribution from the Club's foundation.


