

LIGHTNING POLICY

1. If you see bad weather approaching and you are not comfortable, please come off the course or seek shelter immediately.
2. Even if you have not heard the siren go off indicating lightning in the area, use your common sense and seek shelter. Take appropriate actions to ensure your safety.
3. When you hear the long blast of the siren, the course, putting greens and the driving range are **CLOSED**.
4. Please do not drive your carts into the shelters so all members may access the shelters.
5. Three (3) blasts of the siren indicate that golfers may resume play.
6. Use courtesy and please check with starter when resuming your position on the course.

GOLF CANADA RULES

-Embedded ball through the green may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but no nearer the hole, without penalty. Rule 25-2 applies.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

-White lines or stakes are deemed to be out of bounds. Rule 27-1 applies.

-The stone wall dividing holes #13 and #15, is deemed to be an integral part of the course.

WATER HAZARDS:

-Yellow lines and stakes. Lateral Water Hazards: Red lines and stakes. Rules 26-1 and 26-2 apply.

-Yardage markers and sprinkle head markers are measured to center of the green.

-Yardage posts and sprinkle head markers are obstructions. Rule 24-2 applies.

-All club roads and cart paths are deemed to be obstructions. Rule 24-2 applies.

-The green nursery located to the left of Hole #15 is considered as the wrong putting green. Rule 25-3 applies. The ball must be lifted.

WHITE POSTS WITH GREEN CAPS:

Environmentally Sensitive areas:

The player must lift the ball and drop it, without penalty within one club length of the nearest point of relief - no closer to the hole. You do not need to find your ball.

TEE IT FORWARD:

Players should play from the set of tees that allow for a 4 hour round of golf and make each round of golf more enjoyable. Elm Ridge offers a set of tees for every level of play. Join the movement and "Tee It Forward".
