Important Information



Golfers who applied for **Public Partners Program** passes should have received an email regarding obtaining the actual pass. Please refer to your email from the Kaneohe Klipper Course for details.

All other golfers who provided information before the October 18th deadline will receive gate passes valid only the day of the golf tournament. Various tournament committee members will make their best effort to get your pass to you.

If you do not receive your pass before the date of the event:

\$1,000,000 Hole-in-One at Hole #1 Contest Rules

Open to only registered golfers. Registered golfers must check in **before 11 am** to qualify. Drawing of only one name for chance at **\$1 Million Hole-in-One** will take place at 11:30 am. Golfer whose name is drawn gets one chance on hole #18 at 11:45 am.

Tournament Rules

Format: 4-Player Scramble

Golf Scramble Rules (all golf rules shall conform to USGA Rules):

- Each player in the group tees off. Men tee off from the white tees and women from the red.
- The group decides which shot is the best to keep.
- The other golfers pick up their balls and hit their next shot from the spot of the selected drive. All shots are to be within one club length of the ball.
- The best of the second shot is chosen. This procedure continues until you are on the green.
- In placing the ball you may not change the condition of the shot. If the ball is in a hazard or rough, all players must play from the hazard or rough.
- The group will then putt from the same spot on the green. Two -putt max to speed up playing time.
- Mulligans can be purchased from Check-In. Max 2 mulligans for \$10 each.
- Out-of-Bounds will be treated as a Hazard. Out-of-Bounds will be treated as a Hazard. One-stroke penalty and play from the point-of-entry.
- All rule decisions will be made by the Rules Committee and are final.
