**TERRAIN AND WEATHER**

**OBSTACLES:** There are primarily two types of obstacles you will encounter. Manmade and / or natural. Special rules apply to playing balls that fall in a hazard or obstacle. A ball in any hazard or obstacle may be played as it lies without penalty. If it cannot be played from the hazard, the ball may be hit from another location, generally with a penalty of one stroke or the use of a prepaid mulligan. Watch for bunkers and water obstacles. In addition, watch for the rough characterized by lush vegetation, long grass and tall trees that make it difficult for you to get back onto playable ground.

**EFFECTS ON FRIENDLY:** Increased frustration and higher scores.

**EFFECTS ON ENEMY:** Divot and lost balls. Divots need repairing to keep the course in good condition, so golfers are encouraged to carry a divot tool with them, so they can repair the divots they see. Lost balls belong to the course gods.

**AVENUES OF APPROACH:** 27 holes of well-maintained, championship golf, a 9-hole scenic par 3 course, and an outstanding practice range. With four generous teeing areas, ample fairways, and spacious well-maintained greens.

**EFFECTS ON FRIENDLY:** No more jammed foursomes on every hole which means a pace of play that gets Sonny Simon golfers complete within 5-6 hours.

**EFFECTS ON ENEMY:** The course is played and cleared in a relatively quick manner.

**KEY TERRAIN:** Woods 2 – PAR three – hole in one contest. Verified hole-in-one is awarded a new automobile presented by Smart Motors Toyota.

**EFFECTS ON FRIENDLY:** Joy and Happiness – plus a round at the bar.

**EFFECTS ON ENEMY:** Increased thru-put leads to more happiness for more golfers.

**OBSERVATION AND FIELDS OF FIRE:** Par 3 to 5 – with various doglegs and distances.  
**EFFECTS ON FRIENDLY:** Increased frustration and higher scores.  
**EFFECTS ON ENEMY:** Lost balls and divots.

**COVER AND CONCEALMENT:** All obstacles include trees, a rough area to hit the ball, or water.

**EFFECTS ON FRIENDLY:** Increased frustration and higher scores.

**EFFECTS ON ENEMY:** Increased time in pace-of-play leading to increased levels of frustration for all.

## 1. SITUATION

- a. **Enemy forces.** See Annex A (Intelligence Overlay and Pleasant View Golf Course Score Card)

### (1) Disposition, Composition, and Strength

- (a) **Disposition:** 27 holes of well-maintained, championship golf, a 9-hole scenic par 3 course, and an outstanding practice range. Patio with two fire pits so you can enjoy your favorite food and beverage while overlooking one of the most scenic views in the area. Pleasant View offers sandwiches, burgers, and beverages while you kick back and take in the panoramic sights of Lake Mendota and the City of Madison. The grill is open (when the course is) for breakfast, lunch and dinner or simply for some drinks in the evening.
- (b) **Composition:** Situated on hills approximately 300 feet above Lake Mendota, the Pleasant View Golf Course provides a panoramic view of the City of Madison, WI. Owned and operated by the City of Middleton.
- (c) **Strength:** 18 Hole Scramble Participation with Cart at Pleasant View Golf Course to include Range balls, Lunch, two Drink Tickets per Golfer, Dinner, and Awards Banquet following the Outing.

2. **MISSION:** On 11 JULY 2025, at 1030HRS, various Golfers and Sponsors prepare to cross the line-of-departure (LD) at Pleasant View Golf Course, Middleton, WI to raise awareness and funds for various Veterans organizations and causes in the State of Wisconsin that provide services and support to Veterans in need.

## 3. EXECUTION

**Intent:** Provide awareness of the need to support local Veterans organizations and their mission to provide services to Veterans in need. Raise funds to support those causes and the Veterans they support. Have fun.

- a. **Concept of the Operation.** See Annex C (Operation Overlay)

- (1) 18 Hole Scramble Participation with Cart at Pleasant View Golf Course.
- (2) Valet – provided by your request. Valets will come to your vehicle and deliver

you to in-processing prior to the start of the event.

- (3) Range balls (Firing time: 1130hrs).
- (4) Class I - Chow.
- (5) Class VI - Two (2) Drink Tickets per Golfer.
- (6) Dinner sponsored by Texas Roadhouse and Coin Ceremony following the Outing.
- (7) The satisfaction that funds raised directly support nonprofits and Middleton area Veterans programs.

- (a) We will accomplish this operation by: Playing 18 holes of golf in a scramble and having fun. The decisive point is: Support to Veterans organizations and Veterans in need.
- (b) This is decisive because: Some Veterans continue to deal with the sacrifices and after-effects of their service for years after they leave the Military.
- (c) Thirty-two (32) foursomes, the Main Effort, attack the golf course in a robust manner attempting to score the lowest score of the afternoon.
- (d) VFW 8216, PVGC, and its Sponsors are the supporting effort, provides logistics and sets-up the course for fun. The purpose of this is to: Get the ball in the hole man.
- (e) The End State of this operation is: The completion of 18 holes, a retrograde to the club house where Class I (dinner) will be served and awards presented.

- b. **Coordinating Instructions.** Live scoring is in effect. Please have one individual from your foursome download the Pleasant View App and keep score - <https://www.golfpleasantview.com/app-instructions>

(1) Tournament Rules Scramble Format.

- (a) Each player's Tee Shot must be used at least TWICE in 18 holes.
- (b) Automatic two (2) putt on every green.
- (c) Tee Assignments.
  - a. Men – 60 to 74 – Green Tees.
  - b. Men – 59 and younger – Blue Tees.
  - c. Men 75 and older and Women – White Tees.
- (d) Each team member may hit every shot. The team members are to decide which shot they prefer and then hit from that location. A team member may decide not to hit a shot if they desire. This procedure is repeated until the ball is on the green.
- (e) Each team member may place their ball within one club length of the selected shot no nearer the hole. If the selected shot is in the rough or a hazard, it must stay in the rough or the hazard.
- (f) In the case of a tie score, there will be a scorecard play-off starting with the 9<sup>th</sup> hole on Prairie 9 and moving backward until a winner is decided.
- (g) All teams are made up of four players.
- (h) **REMEMBER: AUTOMATIC** two (2) putt on every green. Please, try and stay up to the group in front of you. Remember to replace all divots and repair all ball marks on the greens. Please keep carts on cart paths around all Tees and Greens.

- (a) **Mulligan:** One (1) free shot by one (1) person per mulligan. Each player may purchase three (3) mulligans, so that's 12 free shots by anyone in the group.
- (2) Par 3 "Hole-in-one" Contest Rules (Not all inclusive) - Smart Motors Inc "**call-for-fire**" "Hole-in-one" betting hole (Must be witnessed by two (2) VFW volunteers) – Woods 2 – With one swing of the club and a minimum \$5.00 bet you could win a 2025 **TBD** (minus taxes and other required payments) sponsored by **SMART MOTORS TOYOTA** of Madison.
- (3) Other Par Three "Hole-in-one" opportunities – witnesses can be members of the foursome for these prizes. Prizes are subject to change.
  - (a) Steak for a year from Omaha Steaks.
  - (b) \$500 Visa prepaid Debit Card.
  - (c) A Bushnell Rangefinder & Wingman GPS Speaker.
- (4) Additional games and fund raisers.
  - (a) **42 Mike-Mike** - fire the JVD Golf "Hot Shot" Air Cannon vs. tee off (\$5).
  - (b) **Check Point** - buy a "par 3". Pay to move your par 5 tee shot to a par three distance. (\$5).
  - (c) **Air Support** (Golf Pro) – Self Managed beat the Pro. (\$5).
  - (d) **Texas Roadhouse** – Self managed game with TRH swag. (\$5)
  - (a) **50/50:** Buy tickets for a chance to win 50% of the total collected. One ticket for \$5, five tickets for \$20. Winner to be drawn at an awards event following golf outing. Must be present to win (Wisconsin State Requirement).
  - (e) **Mulligans:** Three for \$5.00 – limit 3 per player.
  - (f) **Bucket Ticket Raffle:** One for \$5.00, three for \$10.00, ten for \$20. Must be present to win.
- (5) **Bucket Ticket Raffle:** Bid on various items up for auction. The winning bid takes the item home. This year's Raffle will use a bucket to bid. The Bucket Raffle involves multiple prizes with each prize having its own bucket (receptacle) for the deposit of tickets based on your choice. Multiple prizes are up for grabs, and participants can decide which prize(s) they want to try for. Participants can place as many tickets as they'd like into each bucket — boosting your chances of winning a specific item. A ticket is then drawn at random from each bucket to determine the winner.
- (6) **Bar Cart Raffle.** Limited (60) numbered tickets at \$20 each. Win a new Wheelbarrow – filled with your favorite booze by members of the William "Sonny" Simon VFW Post 8216. Winner to be drawn at awards event following golf outing.
- (7) **William "Sonny" Simon Swag.** **New this year** – purchase a T-shirt, hat or polo-shirt or – all three.

  - (b) Prairie 2: **Air Support (Golf Pro): Activity Hole.** Self-Managed. **TBD** Exclusive. Closest to the pin. Prize hole.
  - (c) Prairie 3: Longest Drive in the Fairway. Prize hole.
  - (d) Prairie 5: “Hole-in-one” auxiliary and closest to the pin. Prize hole.
  - (e) Prairie 6: Longest putt. Prize hole.
  - (f) Prairie 8: “Hole-in-one” auxiliary.
  - (g) Prairie 9: Closest tee shot to the American flag in the fairway. Prize hole.
  - (h) Woods 1: **42 Mike-Mike: Activity Hole.** Air cannon “42 Mike-Mike”. **BD Clean LLC** Exclusive.
  - (i) Woods 2: **“Call-for-fire” Smart Motors Toyota** “Hole-in-one”: Main hole in one event w/ Smart Motors Toyota.
  - (j) Woods 4: **Texas Roadhouse:** Self-Managed. Longest drive in the fairway. Prize hole.
  - (k) Woods 5: Longest putt. Prize hole.
  - (l) Woods 6: Closest to the pin in 2. Prize hole.
  - (m) Woods 7: “Hole in one” auxiliary.
  - (n) Woods 9: Shortest drive in the fairway. Prize hole.
- (9) Beverage carts – for your convenience, the staff at Pleasant View will provide two (2) beverage carts. For the enjoyment of all participants and to ensure a speedy pace of play, please wait until you are in the tee box to use these beverage carts. All drink tickets should be redeemed at either the bar or the beverage carts.

Thank you for choosing Pleasant View Golf Course. To ensure everyone has an enjoyable experience, we ask that you help by observing the following:

- USGA rules govern all play except where modified by the following local rules:
- Out of bounds is marked by white stakes, fence, parking lot, or road.
- All unmaintained areas (woods and prairie grass) are to be played as red penalty areas.
- Everyone must check-in and pay for green fees prior to accessing the golf course.
- Fivesomes are A-OK but check with the golf shop staff first.
- Per WI state law, carry-on beverages are not permitted anywhere on the premises.
- You know the saying... "no shirt, no shoes, no service", this includes shorts or pants, too!
- We do not have a lightning detection service in place. Therefore, golfers assume the natural risks associated with playing in inclement weather.
- To help keep everyone safe while on the golf course, please use caution while playing, swing the golf club away from others, yell "fore" should your ball fly astray, and drive with care when using a golf cart.
