The 4th Annual American Legion Texas Post 179 Charity Golf Tournament will be held September 18, 2026, at the Landa Park Golf Course. This scramble-style event is the primary fundraiser for our post's programs, and all of its profits are used to help Veterans and our community. Walton F.
