## Priority Equipment Needs at Ajax Pickering Hospital

### ENTERAL SYRINGE FEEDING PUMPS FOR BABIES



Enteral feeding involves a tube being inserted through the nose going directly into the gastrointestinal tract. The procedure is undertaken to give nutrition to infants who cannot eat on their own (therefore preventing malnutrition) or to provide enhanced nutritional intake.

The feeding tube can be inserted and then removed for each feeding, or it can remain in the infant for multiple feedings.

A feeding tube is used for infants who do not have the strength or muscle coordination to breastfeed or drink from a bottle. An infant may also need a feeding tube because:

- prematurity
- lack of weight gain or irregular weight gain patterns
- absence or weak sucking ability or swallowing reflex
- abdominal or gastrointestinal defects
- respiratory distress
- problems with electrolyte imbalances or elimination

Because of the precise nature of feed required when caring for such a small baby, a pre-set pump pushes the nutrition formula or breast milk from a syringe – at the correct speed and rhythm - through the feeding tube and into the stomach.

The pump is programmed with the necessary information to ensure that the expressed breast milk or formula is dispensed accurately, safely and consistently, as well as minimizing any type of error that could occur. The feeding pump's small size and portability is designed to go wherever patients go.

The use of enteral feeding pumps is now a standards-driven process for patients who require assistance with meeting nutritional requirements, when the oral route is ineffective.

The safety of pumps has evolved with the advent of new closed systems that reduce incorrect administration and microbial risk, as well as the development of feeding pumps that are user-friendly and more accurate in their delivery of enteral nutrition formulae or expressed breastmilk.
