## Rules of the Event:

1. The tournament format is a four-person scramble. Once you select the shot to use, you may place the ball within one club length of the selected shot. However, no nearer the hole or on a different cut of grass (i.e., you cannot move to the fairway from the rough). Once on the green, mark the ball and everyone must putt from this mark. All putts must be holed, no "gimmies"
2. Each person must use at least 3 tee shots. You may use a mulligan coupon if needed. Mark the gross score for the hole the handicap will be calculated at the scorer's table. Please use the tournament scorecard for posting your scores (8 1/2 X 11 card).
3. Mulligan coupons may be used for any shot except on the green. Mulligan coupons are $\$ 5.00$ each. Mulligan coupons may be purchased from volunteers on the golf course during course of play, or from the check-in table when you register. There is no limit on the number of mulligan coupons you can purchase. Mulligan coupons may NOT be used for the hole-in-one prize(s)-see 4 below, nor for $2^{\text {nd }}$ chance long drives.
4. We are offering a $\$ 10,000.00$ hole in one opportunity for all golfers on hole number 13 . Each golfer will have one shot at the chance for a hole in one. The lucky golfer would be awarded $\$ 5,000.00$ and $\$ 5,000.00$ would go to the Youth Benefit Golf Tournament to award scholarships and funding assistance for youth programs. To be eligible for the HIO prize, all tee shots must be taken from the white tees. You may use a mulligan coupon if needed after your hole in one attempt for the tournament score.
5. We will also have hole-in-one opportunities on holes $3,7 \& 15$ as well. Only one chance at the award on each hole. If one of our players makes an ace on hole \#3 using the blue tees, they will receive a $\$ 500.00$ MasterCard pre-paid debit card; on hole \#7 using the white tees, they will receive steaks for a year from Omaha Steaks; and on hole \#15 using the white tees, they will receive a set of Callaway X-Hot Irons. GOOD LUCK EVERYONE!!
6. KP's on the four par 3's are open to all golfers. Mulligans may be used on these par 3's, except for the hole-in-one shot.
7. Use the following tees: Ladies with 24 or less handicap use the yellow tees (except on hole\#14 where all ladies use the red tees). Ladies with 25 or more handicap use the red tees. Ladies in the Duffers division use the red tees. Guys with 10 or less handicap use the blue tees (except on hole \#12 where you will use the white tees): Guys with 11-24 handicap use the white tees: guys with 25 or more handicap and guys in the Duffers division will use the yellow tees (except on number 12 where you would use the white tees). Note: senior guys \& gals ages 70 \& older may move up one set of tees.
8. Men's long drive is hole \#12. All guys use the white tees. The ball MUST be in the fairway grass to be eligible. Gals long drive is hole \#14, all gals use the red tees. Ball MUST be in the fairway grass to be eligible. Old Folks long drive is hole \#17. You must be 65 years of age or older to be eligible. Senior men use white tees, senior ladies use red tees.
9. In the event one of your team members does not show and you have only 3 players you may take a 4th shot rotating the person taking the shot (i.e., player number 1 would take the 4 th tee shot; player 2 the 4 th fairway shot; and player 3 would take the 4th approach shot or putt.
10. Keep carts at least 30 feet from all greens and tees; repair ball marks; replace divots and keep pace. If your ball appears lost, use your partner's shot or use a mulligan coupon. Do not waste time looking for balls. A supply of free replacement preowned low mileage golf balls are available on the white tee boxes of holes $1,4,7,10,13 \& 16$.
11. Water, Gatorade \& soft drinks are available in the coolers at holes $1,4,7,10,13 \& 16$. And at the pro shop dining area. Hot dogs and chips will be available at the turn.
12. We will be able to have a shotgun start this year. Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. followed by a short meeting in the area outside the east entrance to the pro shop at 8:15am.
13. We will have coffee; donuts; orange Juice \& fruit available at the pro shop dining area from 7:30am until the meeting mentioned above at 8:15am. Tee bag prizes will be handed out at registration or placed in your assigned golf cart.
14. We will once again have two beautiful men's \& ladies raffle baskets as well as a few extra raffle gift baskets. Tickets are $\$ 1$ each or 6 for $\$ 5$. Volunteer staff will be available to print labels with your name \& phone \# for you, so buy as many tickets as you wish. We also have several nice silent auction items for you to bid on.
15. Hot dogs and chips will be served at the turn between 9:30 and 12:00. Pin wheel hors d'oeuvres will be served from two rotating golf carts from 10:30 to noon.
16. Upon completion of play please turn your score card asap into the pro shop and proceed to lunch featuring a BBQ Beef Brisket \& Pulled Pork buffet provided by Double JJ BBQ from Albany, OR.

We will also have 3 special on-course contests that will take place on hole \#7 (a par three contest); on hole \#15 (a second par three contest); and on hole \#18 (a long drive contest). The contest providers will be on hand to explain the contest's rules and details upon your arrival at each hole. All contest proceeds will be added to the grants and scholarship donations for our canyon youth.
